

The York University – TD Community Engagement Centre (CEC) is a York University office located off campus in the Yorkgate Mall at Jane and Finch. Members affiliated with the Centre share a commitment to social justice and to community capacity building.

The Centre identifies opportunities for our **students** to **provide services and support to the local community as part of their learning**. As an active community hub we provide space for programs that connect York students and faculty to community partners. Our activities provide valuable services to the area as well as a rich learning environment for our students.

Examples include:

- free Income Tax Clinics for residents of the local community during tax season
- weekly clinics offering free legal advice and referrals
- afterschool activity clubs offering homework help and skill building
- weekly fresh food market selling healthy, affordable food and providing health and nutrition information

The Centre supports increased access to post-secondary education by providing space and support for various access initiatives including York's Bridging Courses for Women and offering monthly General Information Sessions on University Admissions and Financial Aid.

The Centre provides valuable support for **collaborative research activity**. Committed to community based research, the CEC brings together community and university researchers and provides a mechanism to develop a community-informed research agenda.

The Centre offers several free events to educate and/or entertain. We offer a diverse and rotating menu of seminars, concerts, public talks and professional development workshops. Ask us about upcoming events and activities.
